Two excellent opportunities in Information Management Division to serve as an eHHR Program software engineer for Service Oriented Architecture (SOA) enterprise technical products for multiple complex secretariat wide enterprise systems and Agency development projects. This position is responsible for designing, developing and delivering Service Oriented Publish/ Subscribe models for SOAP/HTTP web services, uses Enterprise Application development tools and work flow processes in order to build a robust, highly scalable and distributed SOA enterprise technology. Interested applicants must have knowledge of software that comprises the IBM SOA Foundation for development purposes. Requires ability to create Web services using top-down and bottom-up approaches as well as ability to package and deploy Web services applications to IBM WebSphere Enterprise Service Bus/ IBM Message Broker/ IBM IIB. Requires demonstrated ability to design, create, package, publish, and test Web services. Must have experience working on a development team with a primary focus on IBM WebSphere MQ Publish/Subscribe implementation. Must have working experience with WebSphere MQ V7.x Publish/Subscribe Implementation, WebSphere Enterprise Service, IBM Message Broker, IBM IIB; web services related protocols and standards: SOAP, WSDL, JAX-WS; Java Platform, Enterprise Edition (Java EE), including the Java Message Services (JMS) API and Java EE Connector Architecture (JCA) API; and web services/ application development using IBM WID. Should have knowledge of the Health Insurance Portability and Accountability Act (HIPAA); Agile software development, Health Level 7 (HL7) International standards for the exchange, integration, sharing, and retrieval of electronic health information, and National Information Exchange Model (NIEM) standards. Must have demonstrated ability to quickly adapt to technical environment challenges. Bachelor's degree in information management, information systems, computer science, or engineering preferred; advanced degree and/or professional accreditation/certification as an IBM Certified Solution Developer or IBM Certified Integration Developer is a plus.
